



**Donor Agreement
Between
Honourable Company of Freeman of the
City of London of North America
and
The University of Western Ontario**



The following agreement outlines the specific details of a generous donation of \$25,000 made by Honourable Company of Freeman of the City of London (England) of North America (hereinafter referred to as The Honourable Company) to The University of Western Ontario (hereinafter referred to as the “University”).

Purpose of the Donation:

The Honourable Company’s generous gift of \$25,000 will be used to establish “*The Honourable Company of Freeman of The City of London (England) Scholarship*” at the University for each of five years, in support of the University’s desire to “significantly increase the number of Western students involved in exchange and study-abroad programs, international co-op and work placement, and other international experiences” as part of its Strategic Plan.

This contribution is also made to recognize and strengthen the significant ties between The University of Western Ontario in the City of London, Canada and the City of London, England.

The Honourable Company

The Honourable Company of Freeman of the City of London of North America is an association of Freeman and Liverymen of the City of London (England) who reside in North America. The Honourable Company was founded in 1979 and official recognition by the Lord Mayor and Corporation of the City of London followed in 1980.

Among the objectives of the Honourable Company are:

- to maintain a continuous link with the City of London England;
- where possible to strengthen linkages – commercial, social and personal between the Honourable Company, the City of London England and North America
- to support our charity and each other through meetings and social events

The Scholarship

The Honourable Company of Freeman of the City of London England Scholarship for study in London, England will be awarded to a graduate or undergraduate student in any program of any year who has been accepted for a minimum of three months to pursue course work or significant scholarly activity at a university or college in Greater London Authority or the City of London, England. Preference will be given to graduate students whose scholarly pursuits would benefit from the opportunity to travel and live in London, England. However, undergraduate students applying for an approved exchange program, study abroad or other international experience to take place at a university or college in London, England may also apply. The Honourable Company will endeavour to introduce the student to a Guild event in the City of London, England.

Award applications can be accessed online through Graduate Studies, Registrarial Services and the Exchange Program and Study Abroad web sites, among others. Award applications must be submitted in association with the exchange program, study abroad or other type of application by the specified deadline, including a one-page statement indicating how the award will assist the student in achieving his

or her academic goals. Selection of award recipients will be made by a committee established specific to this award comprised of representatives of Student Development Services, at least one representative from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, and representatives from other programs or departments as required based on the applicant pool.

Students who accept this award must agree to be contacted by the Honourable Company of Freeman of London, Ontario and attend the Annual Dinner of the Honourable Company, in Toronto, Ontario, and speak briefly on the value of the award, upon return to Canada.

Number and Value: One (1) at \$5,000 annually; \$1,000 of the award to support travel cost, including the cost of attendance at the Annual Dinner of the Honourable Company in Toronto.

Effective Date: June 2007 to 2011

Donation Amount and Timing:

The Honourable Company's gift will be received in equal installments of \$5,000 for each of five years, beginning no later than September 30, 2007 and ending September 30, 2011. The University will issue a charitable receipt to the Honourable Company upon receipt of each payment.

University reporting to The Honourable Company

The University agrees to provide a written report to The Honourable Company regarding the recipient of the award each year upon selection, and provide information on the number of applicants and the areas of academic interest represented by the applicant pool.

Recognition:

The University is pleased to provide the following recognition:

- Pending the approval of the Senate and the Board of Governors of the University, the award will be established and named the Honourable Company of Freeman of The City of London, England Scholarship for Study in London, England
- The award will be published on the University's Internet site by the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Registrarial Services and the offices responsible for the Exchange and Study Abroad programs.

Recognition of this gift in donor listings will be in the name of Honourable Company of Freeman of the City of London England of North America unless otherwise indicated by The Honourable Company.

Permission to Alter:

If it becomes necessary to make changes to any other terms of this agreement during its period of execution, any such changes will be made in consultation with The Honourable Company.

The Donor and the University agree to review the terms and application process for the award to determine if any changes are necessary following selection of the third recipient.

Sole Agreement:

This instrument is the sole agreement among the parties with respect to this donation.
